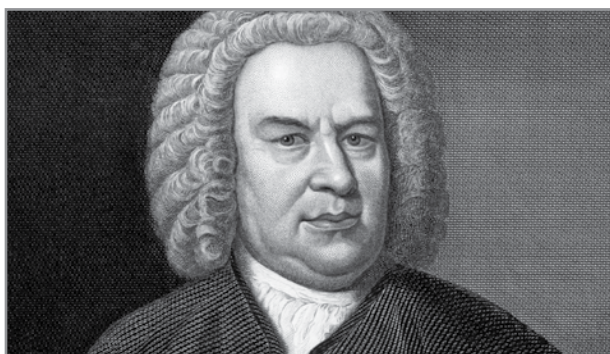
### Messiah George Frideric Handel
